

ShredQuest Rider Briefing

Welcome to **ShredQuest**.

It's a treasure hunt. On bikes.

Imagine if orienteering grew up listening to punk rock and discovered mountain biking.

How it Works

You'll receive:

- One paper map per entry.
- The same map on your phone using the **MapRun** app.

Before you arrive: download **MapRun**. It's free. It's essential. Future You will be very grateful.

On the day we'll give you a code to enter into the app and show you exactly what to do.

When you're ready, press "**Go to Start.**"

From that moment, the clock starts ticking.

You'll have **2 hours** to find as many checkpoints as possible.

Finding Checkpoints

When you reach a checkpoint, your app will automatically register it.

Like magic.

The checkpoint icon changes from **pink to green**, and you'll get a notification.

Top tip: Turn your notification volume up and switch on vibration.

Half the fun is hearing the kids yell "**WE GOT ONE!!**" every few minutes.

Every checkpoint is worth **10 points**.

Simple.

Where Are They?

Most checkpoints are hidden around **Ashton Court**.

Not the usual places.

Not on the Triple Crown race stages.

They're tucked away in corners of the estate you probably haven't ridden before.

Some checkpoints are also in **Leigh Woods**.

Do you have to get them all?

Absolutely not.

In fact, most people won't.

Choose your own adventure.

Leigh Woods

If your route takes you into Leigh Woods, you'll need to cross a few roads.

Please:

- Cross safely.
- Follow the Highway Code.
- Use the traffic lights and cycle crossings where provided.

We'd much rather hear stories about your brilliant route than your impressive emergency stop.

Bikes, Helmets & Fashion Choices

Helmets are mandatory.

Please make sure your bike is safe and in good working order before you start.

Pads are highly recommended...

...but we can't stop you riding in a bikini.

We may question your life choices.

Who Can Enter?

ShredQuest is designed as a **kids' adventure**, but honestly it's brilliant fun whatever your age.

Bring the family.

Bring the grandparents.

Bring the friend who insists they're "just here for the children."

Every family will receive a **Certificate of Completion**.

There will also be prizes for the **top ten teams that include at least one rider under 16**.

Event HQ

All Shredfest rides start from the **Miniature Railway Field** at the top of Ashton Court.

Parking is limited.

If you can, park at **Church Lodge** or somewhere outside the estate and ride in.

Better still...

Ride from home.

At registration we'll ask where you've ridden from.

The family who cycled the furthest to get here will receive a **special prize**.

Because earning your ride before you've even started seems entirely reasonable.

Explore somewhere new.

Get slightly lost.

Find loads of checkpoints.

And remember...

It's only a treasure hunt if someone in your group confidently says,

"I'm sure it's just over this hill..."
